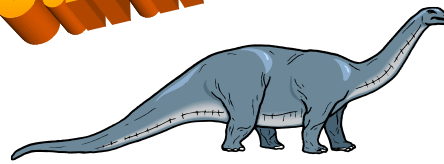


Adventure Safaris

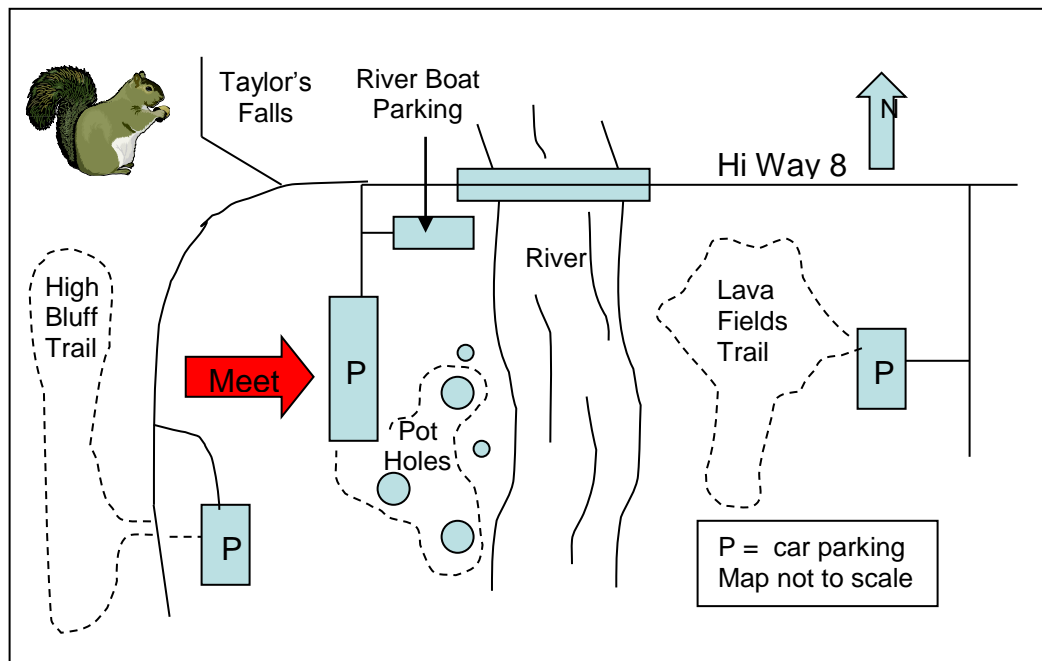
Bring: Sack lunch, Pencil for notes.
