I decided to make a duckbill dinosaur femur out of Styrofoam for an exhibit at the museum. This is light enough that we can take it with us when we go to camps or schools. It weighs about 10 pounds. The real one I'm using as a model weighs 100 pounds and is 4 feet long.

Jay Hardy, the owner of the warehouse where we have our museum, was good enough defer two months of rent. That helped us a lot and we're thankful for his generosity.

Businesses are opening up in Santa Maria. We are praying that things will get back to normal soon.

Depending on the virus, we are planning to go to Minnesota September 3 through the 17th. We will teach at Jana Isaac's homeschool September 9, 10 and 11 and Twin Cities Creation Science Association Tuesday, 7:30 at Northwestern College.

We will do a one-day Adventure Safari to the Saint Paul Science Museum on Saturday the 12th. Participants receive a 30-page book I have written called <u>Giants in the Earth</u>. We look at the giant animals at the museum and show how they fit into the Bible. Examples: giant longnecked dinosaur called the Apatosaurus, giant beaver over 6 feet long, and the biggest flying creature God created; the Pterodactyl with a 40-foot wingspan.

Sunday, September 6 and 13th are open if you'd like to have us speak at your Sunday School, church or youth group on Bible and science, dinosaurs in the Bible or any other topic.

This summer two Bible science camps were canceled which was a large financial loss for us. I had to cancel all classes from Feb.15 onward.
