

ADVENTURE SAFARIS

We have dropped the May 1st. deadline, and any penalty for late registration. We need to have a good estimate of the number of campers by June 15th. Please contact us as soon as possible for reservations and information.

We have selected a 12,000 acre ranch in the Southwest corner of North Dakota for this summer's dig, near the towns of Bowman and Rhame. The ranch is in the Hell Creek Formation located near the Little Missouri River. Two complete Triceratops have been removed from the ranch, so it is in a prime area for digging. Our plan is to have at least three sites open for digging; one of which is identified as a duckbill site. An ideal camping site has been selected with electricity and water nearby.

The town of Bowman, a fast 21 miles to the east, offers several motels and an excellent museum with a dinosaur section. The Black Hills are about three hours south for those who want to extend their vacation. Theodore Roosevelt National Park and a great museum in Dickinson, ND are each about 1 1/2 hours away.

We look forward to the fellowship with other believers this summer and to the rewarding experience of unearthing evidence of dinosaurs laid down by the Flood.

We have scheduled January 31 and February 1, 1998 for next year's Science Fair at HAR MAR MALL. They want us back since there was positive feedback and because business was up. This is a wonderful opportunity to extend the Creation message to the community.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
