Pastor Paul A. Bartz - May 1, 1948 – Aug. 15, 2013

In addition to being editor of the *Bible-Science Newsletter* from 1981 to 1992, Paul served as secretary of the **Bible-Science Association** – which was later renamed **Creation Moments**. Paul preached, lectured, taught and was a prolific author, writing more than 500 articles, editorials and Bible studies on creation during his tenure as editor. He was also the author and editor of the *Our Science Reader Books*-curriculum for children K-12.

In 1987, Paul and the late Brad Walton created and produced the radio program "Creation Moments." Paul went on to write more than 1,600 transcripts that are broadcast to this day around the world in multiple languages. The scripts have been printed in the popular six-volume set: *Letting God Create Your Day*.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
