Bill Nye the "Science Guy" Does he really know Science?

Many people have said that they were frustrated over the debate between Bill Nye and Ken Ham. They felt Ken should have addressed Bill Nye's criticisms more specifically. Ken Ham was attacking the basic philosophy of evolutionism and did not get into the specifics too much with Nye. Russ McGlenn has taken some of Nye's statements and will show that they are not scientifically accurate and that he is speaking from a lack of scientific knowledge. ...There are two types of science, *historical science* and *operational science*. *Operational science* is the stuff of test tubes, experiments and observation. *Operational science* involves hypothesis's being rigorously tested again and again to verify its truth. This results in wonderful new inventions such as computers and cell phones. *Historical science* is different. It is a belief about the universe or how life began. To be a historical scientist is like being a detective trying to solve a crime, what happened in the past. This can involve many different interpretations, which cannot be scientifically tested. Evolution falls under *historical science*. *Operational science* is based on the scientific method not on subjective opinions as with *historical science*. So when you hear someone speaking say, "Science says..." check in your mind is it *operational science* or *historical science*.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. 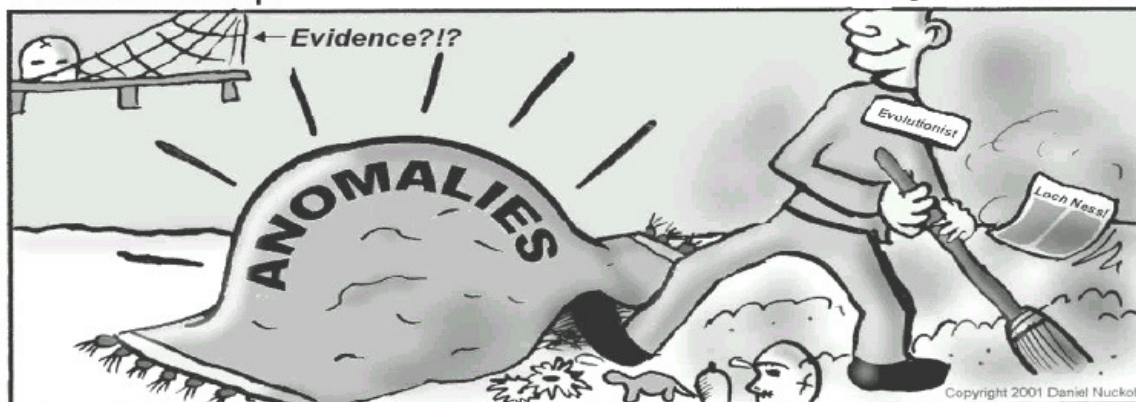
