How Did Noah Build the Ark?

With Noah's pre-Flood intelligence, his focus on the purpose God assigned for his life, and communication with the Creator Himself, he was able to complete the construction of the Ark from the basic instructions we find in Scripture. There is evidence that ships approaching the size of the Ark have in fact existed in ancient times. The ancient Greeks built a ship named Syracusia (or Alexandris) that carried around 4,000 tons of cargo. The pre-modern Chinese also built giant wooden ships. The 15th-century sea-going junks of the ambassador Cheng Ho approached the size of the Ark (John Woodmorappe, "Noah's Ark Feasibility Study," Dallas, TX: Institute for Creation Research, p. 50). Have you considered...

...Painted lady butterfly migration. Many have heard of the monarch butterfly migrating some 4,000 miles from Canada to Mexico and back but have you heard of the painted lady butterfly migration? This butterfly migrates between Europe and Africa and back, flying an incredible 9,000 miles round trip! Why has this not been discovered until recently? Because they fly at altitudes up to 3,000 feet and at speeds of 30 mph. Radar is what revealed the millions migrating. Radar with citizen scientists verified the migration. More than 60,000 sighting of painted lady butterflies revealed that they fly as far north as the Arctic Circle. The 9,000 mile round trip migration takes a number of generations. Over a year, up to six successive generations migrate. For example a butterfly might fly from Norway to Britain where it will breed and die, the next generation will carry on the migration to Africa. This tiny creature weighing less than a gram with a pin-sized head having no opportunity to learn the migration route from an older butterfly, undertakes this epic migration! How do they know where to go? Evolution says this all happened by chance. How could it? How would the painted lady evolve the ability to fly to a place they have never been before? God set this up from the beginning to show his great power. God has bound the information into the genetic code of each butterfly so that each "knows" at what stage of the migration cycle the butterfly is in. This information is passed on to each generation. Such a delicate mechanism shouts intelligent design!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
