The Heavens Declare the Glory of God

Tues, July 19, 7:30, Nazareth Hall Chapel, Univ. of Northwestern, 3003 N Snelling, Roseville

Did God create the Universe, as the Bible says? Or did the Universe form itself in a Big Bang event instead? A close look at scientific literature reveals a surprising truth: Secular astronomical models cannot explain the origins of things we see in space, including stars, galaxies, the planets, and indeed, the entire cosmos itself. In this presentation, full of photographs and graphics from NASA and other sources, you'll see that the Universe is inconsistent with random evolutionary models. Instead, the heavens declare the glory of God. Our guest speaker, Spike Psarris, was an engineer in the US military space program. He entered that program as an atheist and an evolutionist, and left as a creationist and a Christian. He now speaks on science, creation, and the Bible, and is the author/producer of the DVD series "What You Aren't Being Told About Astronomy."

Have you considered...

...clockworks in space? Starting with our own solar system, we find the planets orbit all the same way, in an anticlockwise direction as viewed from above. Each planet's orbit is stable and precise. If the planet did not have orbital motion, the Sun would pull them in and burn them up. The orbit being nearly circular keeps planets from straying into another planet's orbit. All the planets orbit the sun in about the same plane (called the ecliptic), this allows for easier location from earth AND for the large gas giants to protect earth from comet-sized bodies.

The Milky Way Galaxy also shows clockwork motion. The stars in our galaxy orbit the central hub in such a manner that gravity keeps the stars in a stable orbit. These billions of stars all travel in the same direction thereby preventing collisions.

Clockwork motion cries out that there must be a clock-maker. We do not say a clock made itself. Clockwork motion means there is One who is a clockmaker and that One is God. The heavens do declare the glory of God!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
