The Scientific Approach to Evolution

Have You Considered... Venezuela mountain streams have both colorful and drab male guppies. The population of colored fish goes up or down depending on predation pressures. When predators are few or absent, brightly colored males predominate and female guppies mate with them producing more brightly colored guppies. However, when predators were abundant, the easily-spotted colorful males are eaten so females mate with the drab males producing drab colored young. This is natural selection in action. Natural selection eliminates, it does not create.

Another example: Tibetan snow lotus seeds are prized for Chinese medicine. During the last 50 years, the snow lotus plants have halved in height. Why? Harvesters scouring the slopes believe that the taller plant seeds are more potent, leaving mostly shorter plants to reproduce. The genes for tallness are slowly being removed from the Himalayas.

Evolution is not taking place, just natural selection working with available information. No new information is added! Natural selection can only eliminate, never create! Catchpoole, David. "Isn't it Obvious? Natural selection can eliminate but never create!" *Creation* 39(1) 2017. p. 38-41.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
