...fossilized leaves? Check it out. They are wonderfully preserved! Plant leaves separated from the plants soon curl and shrivel up but that is not what we find with fossilized plant leaves. How did they become so exquisitely preserved? During the Flood of Noah's time leaves were ripped off plants. The fresh leaves would have floated on the ocean and absorbed water causing them to straighten and become flatter than what we normally see in life. Then the leaves were buried with sediment before having a chance to decay. All around the world we find these amazingly preserved, flattened leaf fossils.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths. We believe that the origin of matter and all basic types of living things, including man, came about through direct creative acts of God during the six-day creation week described in Genesis. Whatever biological changes have occurred since the creation week have accomplished only changes within the created kinds. We believe that the great flood described in Genesis, commonly referred to as the Noachian Flood, was an historic event, world-wide in extent and effect. We accept the account of the special creation of Adam and Eve as the first man and woman. Their subsequent fall into sin, by disobedience of God's direct command, is the basis for our belief in the necessity of a Savior for all mankind. Therefore, we believe that Jesus Christ is our Lord and only Savior and that personal faith in Him is necessary for salvation.


