Have you considered...

... how the continental margins (continental shelf and continental slope) were made. At the end of Noah's Flood the continents rose causing the flood waters to massively pour off the continents in sheets. These fast moving waters eroded vast amounts of recently laid down sediments. These currents traveled so fast that the sediments were not deposited on land but were deposited when they reached the oceans and the currents slowed, dropping their load.

Continental margins surround all continents and make up some 20 % of the ocean floor; the remainder are the deep ocean basins. The continental margins are made of sedimentary rocks which can be up to 12 miles deep. The continental shelf, the first part of the continental margin, is fairly flat and varies in width from a few miles wide to 600 miles wide! The continental slope averages 430 feet in depth continuing down to 4,900-11,500 feet. The continental margin is a mystery to evolutionists, how could it form with slow and gradual processes? From an evolutionary view point there should be NO continental margins! How were the continual margins made? The rapid runoff during the Genesis Flood formed the continental margins.
