# Flood Geology of Wisconsin

May 15, 7:30 PM, Totino Bldg. Room F2128, Univ. of Northwestern, 3003 N Snelling, Roseville, MN

What is the significance of the wonderful rock formations we see in Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan? When were they deposited? Many thousands or millions of years ago as the long age people believe? Or, recently by Noah's Flood? This talk shows how the Noah's Flood record helps us to understand the geology of our area. This talk will look at the geology of specific locations in Wisconsin in a chronological "tour" of the geologic processes that operated during the stages of the global Flood and during the subsequent ice age. We can see features associated with the breaking up of the fountains of the deep, flood sedimentation, formations formed by receding flood waters, and ice age features all in our own backyard. Perhaps you will get some ideas for your next creation vacation.

#### Have you considered...

...fossilized ripple marks. This very common fossil is found worldwide especially in sandstone formations. Fossilized ripple marks are identical to today's ripple marks. Ripples are formed as water moves over sand. There are two types of ripple marks, those found along beaches and those found on ocean bottoms formed from strong currents. Ripple marks are made in wet sand. They can easily be wiped away, just like a sandcastle on a beach is gone in a few days. To have ripple marks preserved requires rapid coverage and a cementing agent such as calcium carbonate, silica, or iron. We do not see ripple marks becoming fossils today. What event in history has water world-wide and rocks being ground up into sand with cementing agents? The Flood of Noah's day. This very common world-wide fossil has been frozen in time to give testimony to this catastrophic Biblical event. http://www.creationsciencetoday.com/18-Fragile Surface Features.html

#### TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
