You've Come a Long Way Baby

You've Come a Long Way, Baby! - The Transition from Prenatal to Postnatal Circulation. This fascinating presentation discusses the physical changes that must occur in the circulatory system for a baby to make the transition from life in the womb to the outside world. Many of the contributing factors that stimulate these changes are also given, demonstrating the irreducible complexity of the mammalian system of giving birth. A medical case history is presented with a surprise ending, and the relevance of all of this to Genesis is demonstrated.

Joseph Kezele, MD earned his medical degree at the College of Medicine, University of Arizona and is currently an assistant biology professor at Arizona Christian University. He has been active in researching and speaking since 1993 and is also a founding staff member of www.creationtraining.org.

What Type of Science Should be Taught in Public Schools?

"You can't teach creation science in public schools, remember, the separation of church and state and God can't be mentioned?" With that statement, we allow evolution to be taught in public schools.

Maybe our debate is not between creation and evolution. Maybe our debate should be whether we teach observational science or historical science. Let's define terms. Observational science are the things we observe, test, and are repeatable. It's the scientific method. It's the stuff of test tubes and telescopes. Historical science is about the past. Is evolution the true past or is creation the true past? Let's examine.

- ♦ Evolution, did anyone observe it, can it be repeated? NO, so it is a philosophy of the past.
- ♦ Creation science, did anyone observe it, is it repeatable? NO, so it too is a philosophy of the past.

Both are philosophies, not the science of test tubes and the scientific method. We should jettison philosophies, leaving that for philosophy classes, and teach true science, observational science, the observable, testable, scientific method type of science in public schools! Innovations and inventions of tomorrow will be based on observational science not historical science. So, let's teach true science-observational science and not philosophy in public school Science classes!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

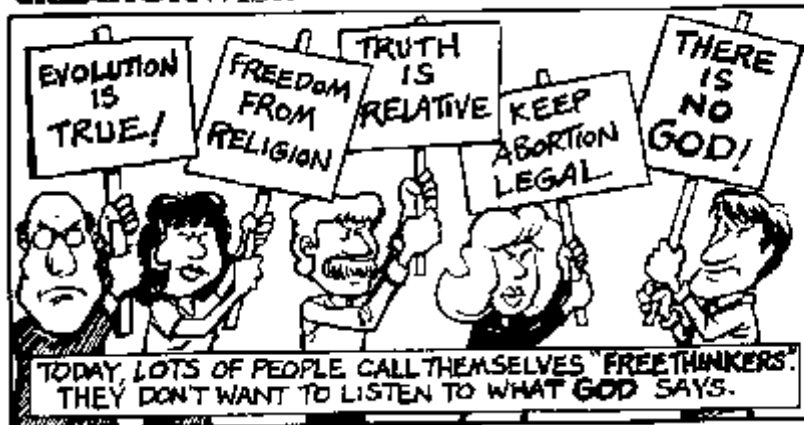
