Creation and Design Features in Costa Rica

For several years, Dave and Mary Jo Nutting have experienced amazing design features found in the plants, insects, and animals of Costa Rica. In this extremely colorful PPT presentation, they will share the best of these fabulous features. Marvel at not only the breath-taking photos, but also how the extremely diverse ecosystems of Costa Rica reflect the Biblical framework of the Creation, the Fall, Flood, and Dispersion.

Have you considered... Giant monsters. Did you know that in the past fantastically gigantic monsters existed? Here is but a partial list:

- Bears standing 6 feet at the shoulder weighing some 2,200 pounds.
- Camels standing 13 feet tall as compared to today at 7 feet tall.
- Imagine beavers standing 8 feet tall, the size of a black bear.
- Sharks (megalodons) 50-80 feet long as compared to the largest today, the great white shark at 21 feet.
- Penguins standing 6.6 feet tall while today's tallest, the emperor penguin standing at 3.75 feet. Interestingly, the larger the penguin, the deeper it could dive and the longer it can stay underwater. These giants could stay submerged for some 40 minutes, while today's penguins only about 27 minutes.

All over the world these giants have been discovered in fossil form. And then they all seemed to die out at the same time. In the past there was more variety of beavers, camels, penguins and other creatures. These creatures were created by God, lived in a perfect world, until the Fall came. With the Fall came the curse of sin, and the world started to deteriorate. Noah's flood destroyed all living animals that "had the breath of life in its nostrils" (Genesis 7:22). After the Flood, they repopulated the world. The post-flood world was still favorable for these giants and they flourished. The Flood set up the right conditions for the one and only Ice Age. One third of the earth was covered in ice (the higher latitudes) while other parts of the world experienced lots of rain fall and the tropics flourished. After 700 years the climate changed, some tropical regions of the world dried out and became deserts. Without adequate food these giant creatures died off. Today we are left with smaller and less variety in the animal kingdom. In his book Untold Secrets of Planet Earth: Monumental Monsters, Vance Nelson documents 35 giant animals: rabbits, bison, frogs, hyenas, rhinos, rats, platypuses, raccoons, millipedes, land scorpions and 25 others.

Today's world of animals has less variety, smaller bodies and are not as vigorous. The demise of giant creatures shows us that the animal kingdom is declining; this is the exact opposite of evolutionary ideas. Evolution says that things are getting better and better but that is not what we observe in nature. The world is decaying, running down. Those giant creatures from the past would have been a wonder to see!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF


