Amber and Honey

Tuesday July 16, 7:30 PM, Totino Fine Arts Center, Room FAC 2106, Univ. of Northwestern, 3003 N Snelling Dr. Joseph Kezele, MD returns with another great topic. He will be discussing the formation of amber during Noah's Flood, special properties of honey, and unique behaviors and anatomy of honeybees involved with honey production. Amber formation and distribution can only be explained by a global flood. You will be amazed to learn the intricate details of how God put together the honeybee and the constituents in honey. Have You Considered...

Can an insect keep its wings free of bacteria without chemicals? Yes! Believe or not, it's the structures on its wings that kills the bacteria. The wings of a Clanger cicada have blunt nano-structure pillars. When a bacterium lands on these blunt pillars, the bacterium's elastic skin is stretched as it descends between the pillars causing the bacterium's skin to tear resulting in death. This is similar to a water balloon on a bed of blunt nails. As the water balloon descends between the blunt nails the balloon skin is stretched and torn resulting in a ripped balloon and water everywhere.

The cicada's wing design is the **first known physical structure to kill bacteria**. Scientists are excited to see how they will use this design to make antibacterial surfaces in hospitals, schools and homes without chemicals. Scientists recognize a good design when they see it. Maybe soon you will grab a doorknob covered with antibacterial nanopillars copied from the wing of a cicada. Cicada wing doorknobs! Cicada wing handrails! TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF




