What Are the Created Kinds?

Tuesday October 15, 7:30 PM, Totino Fine Arts Center, Room 2106, Univ. of Northwestern, 3003 N Snelling

A familiar question is "How did Noah get all the species of animals in the Ark?" Noah did not put a pair of every species in the Ark just a pair of each "Kind" of animal. This talk will define a Kind, describe natural selection in terms of Kinds, provide examples of different Kinds and describe how animals are placed into Kinds by people known as baraminologists.

Jim Orme has degrees in Bible and math and worked for Bell Telephone for about 30 years. He Worked on Space science and Telecommunications projects for Bell. Was elected to the position of Senior Member of the IEEE. He founded and led the Northwoods Creation Assoc. in Ashland, WI for 6 years and remains active there.

Have You Considered...

...the Philippine snout weevil's coloring? This small beetle has rainbow circles on its wing casings and thorax. The circular scales start with a blue center to yellow to red with all the rainbow colors in-between. These colors are not produced by pigments but by structure. What's unusual about these colors is **they remain the same from every angle!** The chitin structures are 3-D with the size, structure, and volume determining the color displayed. Smaller scales with smaller crystals and less chitin reflect blue light while the larger scales with large crystals and more chitin reflect red light. The crystalline structure splits the sunlight like a prism, creating the rainbow of colors. What is more **unusual and rare** is that the colors remain true no matter which angle observed from. If human engineers could copy this, they could apply it to any industry with color productions such as paints and cosmetics. Engineers have not even come close to having true color fidelity made this way. Nature's engineer has outdone human engineers. Who is nature's engineer? God Himself!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF




