## When Did the Cavemen Live ... and More?

Tuesday March 16, 2021, 7:30 PM This is a live Zoom meeting, a recording will be on DVD later. You hear of “cavemen”, “hunter-gatherer”, the “bronze and iron ages”, etc. but how accurate are these terms and where do these really fit into a historically accurate timeline? We will look at who cavemen were and why they were. We will spend the first 10 minutes looking at how you can know what I am saying is accurate. You may find this helpful for you to evaluate the accuracy of information from the media. Then we will sort out some of the mixture of myth and truth surrounding cavemen.

This will be based around a bigger picture of a timeline based on the oldest written records (including the Bible), archaeology, genetics, geology, and the Hebrew language. The timeline being used is probably accurate within about 150 years and generally within 50 years or less.

Don Slinger has a B.S. in Wildlife Management from the University of Minnesota and is a graduate of Police Staff and Command from Northwestern University. During his 33 years in natural resource law enforcement he fine-tuned his investigation skills which now help him sort for accurate information. He also served a number of years on the Twin Cities Creation Science Association board of directors.

... cave homes? When we hear the word “cavemen” we often think of primitive people wearing bear skin clothing and carrying wooden clubs. In fact, people have always lived in caves throughout history; some even live in caves today. In the Yellow River region of China some 20 million people are still living in caves. These caves are carved out of silty soil and are packed so hard that they do not need supports, the caves usually measure 10 x 13 feet and extend 20 to 25 feet into the hillside. The caves are warm in the winter and cool during the hot summer. They have many of the modern comforts such as plumbing, electricity and even cable television. Caves are a great place to live as 20 million Chinese can attest to. Are these people primitive? Hardly! People assume based on evolutionary ideas that people that lived in caves were primitive brutes. In Genesis 10 we read of the tower of Babel and the people being scattered throughout the world, some sought shelter in caves as they built more permanent homes. Today we often find their archeological remains in caves like Neanderthal man. The fact that they lived in caves does not make them primitive; it's just another housing choice.

#### TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

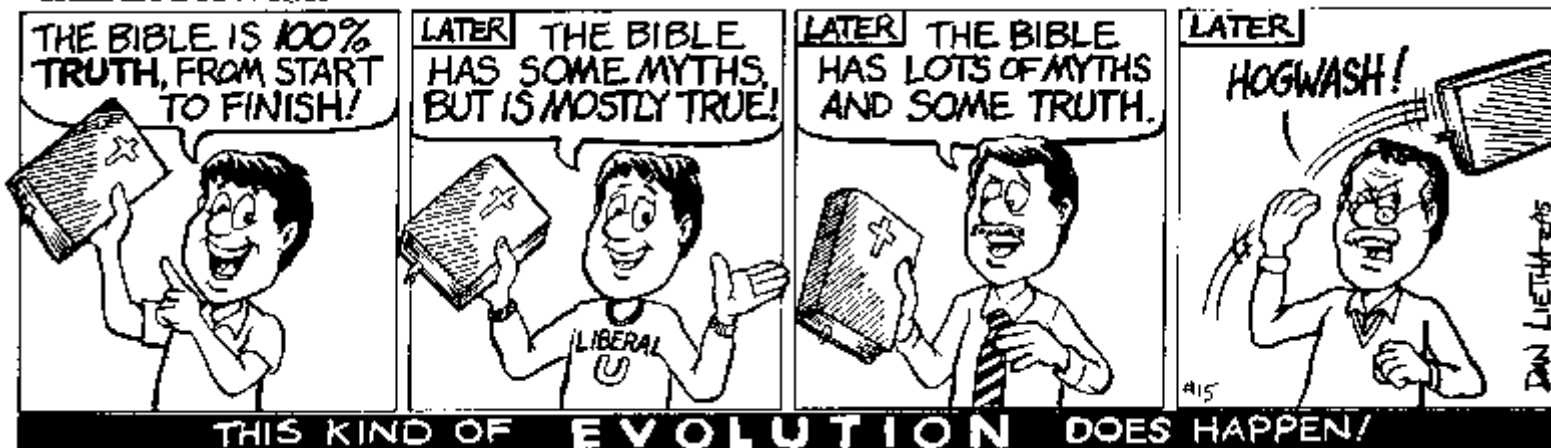
