# The Truth of the Global Flood:

## An Examination of the Geological Data

Tuesday August 17, 2021, 7:30 PM, 3003 N. Snelling, Roseville, Totino Fine Arts Center F2106 Carousel In this presentation, Dr. Timothy Clarey from ICR, shows how sedimentary evidence across several continents confirms the occurrence of a global flood. He presents oil industry data compiled into maps and diagrams that illustrate the progression of the Flood and match the biblical narrative. He provides biblically based scientific explanations for large-scale sedimentary deposits that were rapidly formed by catastrophic activity. This abundant evidence supports a worldwide flood that happened just thousands of years ago. Dr. Clarey will be presenting this via ZOOM to our meeting at Northwestern because his schedule prohibits his coming in person. We can attend in person or via ZOOM if desired. Have you considered...

...the oldest known living trees? A bristlecone pine named "Old Methuselah" is about 4,723 years old. The 2<sup>nd</sup> oldest tree a Patagonian Cypress is 3,631 years. In California's Sequoia National Park, "General Sherman" has been dated at 2,150 years old. While, fallen and cut sequoias show ages exceeding 3,000 years. Notice the ages of the trees – roughly 2,000 to 4,700 years old. The world-wide flood in Genesis 6-8 was about 4,500 years ago.

What is the oldest petrified tree? At Florissant Fossil Beds in Colorado, the oldest petrified sequoia was close to 1,500 years old when it died. Yellowstone Park's "fossil forests" date about 1,000 years old at the time of their burial. This is far from mature specimens at the time of their demise. Fossil Trees in England, in the Arctic and Antarctic show a maximum age of 1,000 years. Scientists have never found a petrified tree older than 1,500 years old. The pre-flood world lasted about 1,656 years. Something killed the trees before they matured. The Flood of Noah's day killed and caused them to be petrified. Petrified trees, with their dates no greater than 1,500 years, give testimony to the biblical pre-flood world lasting about 1500 years.
