Have you considered...

As I take a wintery walk in February, I ask, "Is that a butterfly I see fluttering in this Minnesota winter?" Yes! There are butterflies that winter over and when it warms up a bit they will venture out from hibernation. Depending on the species of butterfly they will overwinter in one of the stages of a butterfly's lifecycle. Some will overwinter as eggs, others as caterpillars. Many swallowtail butterflies overwinter as chrysalises. Then there are butterflies such as the Mourning Cloaks that will overwinter tucked away in log crevices or underneath loose bark. On the very first warm day of spring they venture out, even occasionally during warm spells in January and February.

Being cold-blooded, they take on the surrounding temperatures, so, how are they able to survive these below zero temperatures? The secret is the antifreeze in their bodies. As days become shorter in Fall, they begin secreting antifreeze into their cells. Now when it gets brutally cold, ice crystals can't form and rupture the cells. Our cars use antifreeze in the winter. Do we think that the car's antifreeze came about by accident and chance? No, there had to be an antifreeze maker. In the same way, the butterfly's antifreeze could not have come about by accident and chance but there had to be an antifreeze maker otherwise there would be no butterflies! Who is the butterfly's antifreeze maker? God Himself. So, the next time you take a winter walk consider all of the butterflies tucked away behind tree bark waiting to fly again.

Butterflies you may see on an above freezing winter day in Minnesota: Question Mark, Eastern Comma, Mourning Cloak, and Compton Tortoiseshell.

TCCSA'S STATEMENT OF BELIEF


