Have you considered ...

The Bogong moth? It's crazy but true—Bogong moths of Australia migrate 620 miles (1,000 kilometers) by night from the plains of eastern Australia to Australia's mountainous Alps. Billions of moths make this journey to find a cave and lie dormant till autumn when they fly back, mate, lay eggs and die. Their progeny repeats the same journey without any experience or guide. Curious scientists wanted to know how the moths navigated. So, they tethered migrating Bogong moths in an outdoor flight simulator. Sure enough, the moths used the earth's magnetic field to navigate. How were the moths able to do this? Scientists are testing the idea of cryptochromes, a Greek word for hidden colors. Cryptochromes are molecules in the eyes which are sensitive to blue light and are thought to help the moth sense the magnetic field. When the magnetic field was removed, the moths were still able to navigate using the starry night. Inside the moth's brain, which is a tenth of the volume of a grain of rice and eyes which are smaller than a pinhead, is a compass to help the moth navigate. Do compasses happen by accident and chance? No, there had to be compass maker and that compass maker is God.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
