All meetings are free and open to the public


Have you considered ...

... scientists have uncovered five octopus fossils. Octopuses are soft bodied animals and remarkably each octopus had eight of its arms fossilized with traces of muscles and rows of suckers. Some even had internal gills and ink fossilized! Today when an octopus dies it does not exist for very long, it decomposes into a slimy blob and within days, scavengers and bacteria cause it to disappear.

For an octopus to fossilize would take very special conditions: fast, deep coverage with no oxygen. These special conditions would have been met in the Flood of Noah's day.

Furthermore, these five octopuses were enclosed in limestone. Limestone is considered by evolutionists to take long periods of time to form. During the Flood of Noah's time conditions would have been right for rapid limestone formation. Fossils continue to give evidence that the Flood of Noah's day did occur.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We are Blessed


