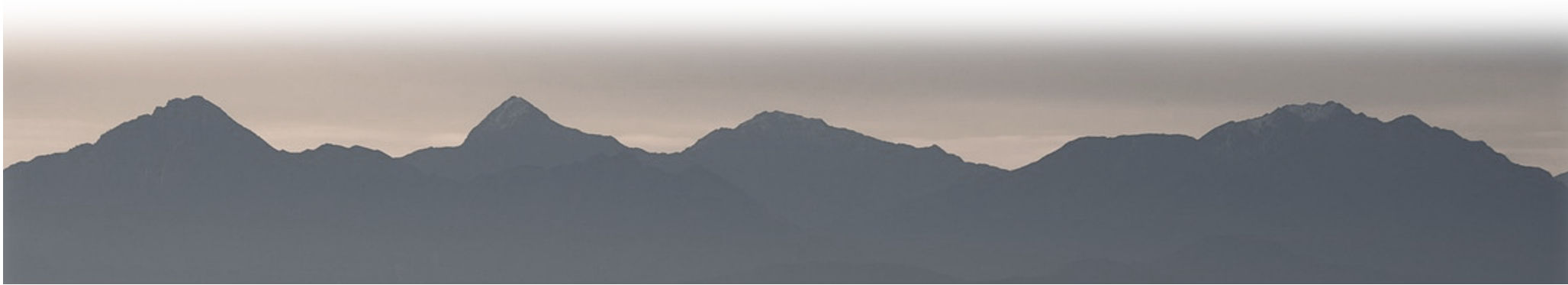
Can You Be a Point Person?

Many Christians shy away from the issue of creation vs. evolution. Why? Because they think creation is either not important, not credible, or divisive.



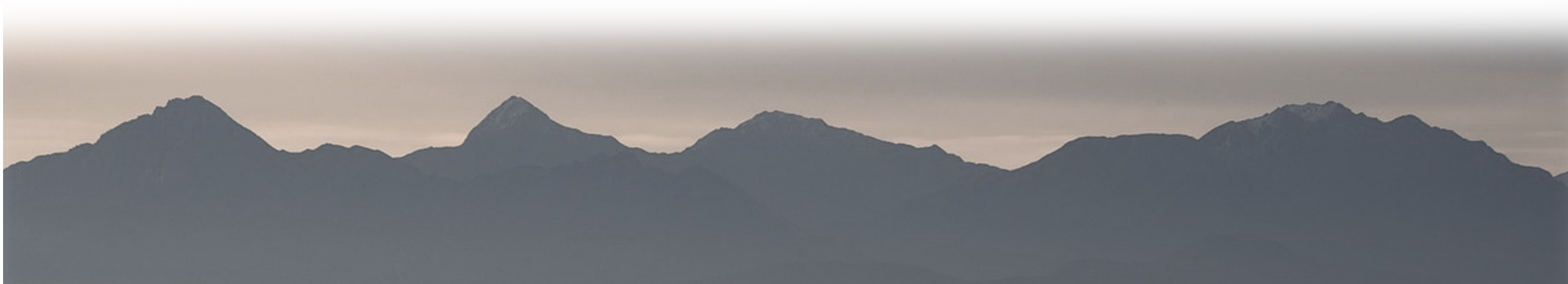
Is It Important?

Regular TCCSA attenders know that creation is actually far more credible than evolution and is more important to the gospel than most realize.



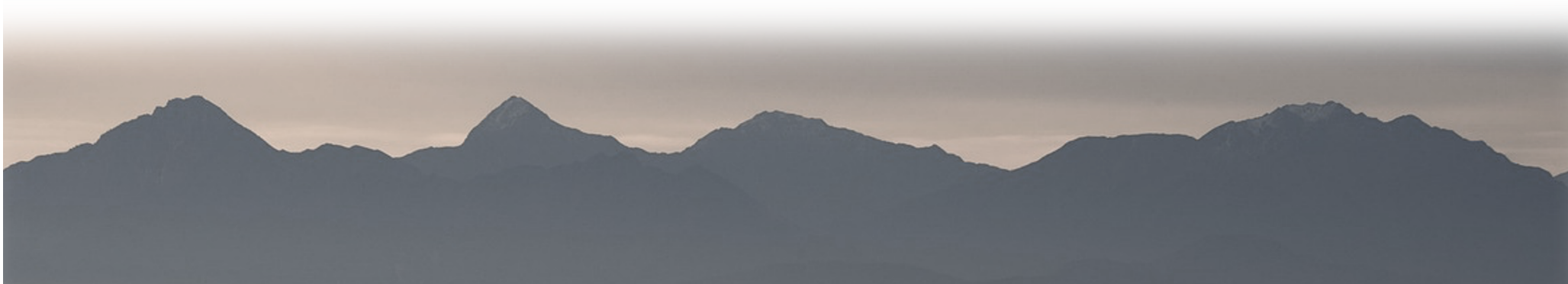
Why Is It Important?
